WHAT TO BRING: Appropriate clothing for cool weather and the chance of rain, sleeping bag, pillow, toiletries, including towels, flashlight, Bible and notebook. If possible provide your own fly fishing equipment, vessel to fish from in the lake, fly tying kit, etc. Don't forget to bring extra cash for the raffle, we always have some great items!

WHAT TO EXPECT: Great spiritual fellowship, high quality instruction in fly fishing skills, outstanding meals and generally good fishing!

LODGING: Bunkhouse style cabins are provided, rooming 8 to 12 people each. There are now 6 deluxe cabins (room for 6) with shower and toilet, as well as 2 deluxe cabins (two bathrooms with room for 12). Deluxe cabins are available first-come, first-serve, with a \$20 per bathroom cleaning fee. There is limited space for tents and small RV's, contact John for more info. It is highly recommend that you bring ear plugs if you sleep in a cabin and are a "light" sleeper!

NO SWIMMING: There are no lifeguards on duty, so please refrain from swimming.

FISHING: Fishing inside the lake to the west of the dyke where the creek flows in is open to fishing "without" an Oregon fishing license. This part of the lake is owned by Camp Morrow and is about 5 or so acres. Fishing on the right side of the dyke is Pine Hollow Reservoir and requires an Oregon state fishing license. The state plants rainbow trout on a regular basis averaging 8 to 12 inches. Holdovers and brood stock trout can range from 14 to more than 20 inches and are caught on occasion. Largemouth bass and bluegill are also very common, especially near the camp.

CATCH & RELEASE FISHING! We do not allow dead fish to be refrigerated or frozen using the dining hall facilities. We encourage catch & release fly fishing only.

REFUNDS: We will do our best to apply a complete refund pending the circumstances. If you know ahead of time please give us reasonable notification. We reserve the right to apply a reasonable service fee. Please note : There are **no refunds after the Monday following Mother's Day unless it is a verifiable emergency!**

Directions From The Dalles: From I-84, take the Dufur/Bend exit (#87) south on HWY 197, go about 33 miles. Not long after you come off a very long grade and the hiway makes a left hand bend, turn right at the flashing light into Tygh Valley. At the intersection in Tygh Valley, turn right onto Wamic Market Rd and follow it about 6 miles to the intersection in Wamic. Go straight onto Dodson Rd and follow it 3 miles. Dodson Rd becomes Morrow Rd, Camp Morrow will be on your right. Camp Morrow is on the west shore of Pine Hollow Res. If you get lost, call John, 503-883-3480 or Marc, 503-473-5382

CAMP RULES:

--Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited on camp grounds!

--Designated smoking area is at the basketball court, please respect others if they are shooting hoops.

--**Please do NOT drive on lawn to launch your boat!** There is a boat launch at the south end of the reservoir for trailered boats. There's plenty of folks to help carry or unload boats at camp if yours is vessel is light enough.

--Friday night dinner will be served starting at 6:30 pm and is typically served until food runs out. Sorry, we cannot hold meals. Highly recommended you stop and get a bite to eat if you can't make dinner.

--No wet wading boots or waders allowed indoors in any of the camp buildings! Please remove your wet gear before entering!

--Fishing is done at your own risk! Please abide by all laws and remember to have your personal floatation device. Also, please note that the lake speed limit is 10 mph.
